Unlimited Use of HOV Lane by Electric Vehicles

Short Description: Unlimited use of HOV lanes by a properly licensed electric vehicle with special clean fuel decal.

Beneficiary: Driver of properly licensed electric vehicle

Type of Incentive: Transportation Benefit

Effective Dates: Current Benefit through September 30, 2025

Value of Benefit: Non-cash benefit

Full Description:

Vehicles with clean fuel decals are authorized to travel in HOV lanes regardless of the number of occupants (41-6a-702(5)(a)). The clean fuel decal is issued by Utah Dept. of Transportation and a limited number of decals are available. Vehicle owners must first obtain a C Plate permit from the Utah Department of Transportation. To be eligible for a special clean fuel decal, a vehicle must meet the requirements of a clean fuel vehicle. Electricity meets the clean fuel requirements in the Utah Statute (59-13-102).

- Permanent license plate numbers are required at the time of application.

- To transfer a pass – Include your current permit number, license plate number, VIN or pass number in the appropriate section of the application.
